Bow Tie Taco Casserole

Ingredients:

1 pound ground beef

1 package taco seasoning

1/2 cup diced green pepper

1 (15 ounce) can tomato sauce

1 (14.5 oz) can diced tomatoes

2 cups dry bow tie pasta (4 cups cooked)

1 ½ cups shredded Monterey jack cheese

1/2 cup sour cream

Directions:

Spray casserole pan with cooking spray.

Cook Bow Tie pasta according to package directions and drain

In large skillet, brown ground beef. Drain and set aside.

Stir in the taco seasoning mix, tomato sauce, diced tomatoes and green pepper.

Bring to a boil then reduce heat and simmer for 10 minutes

Combine pasta with 1/2 cup cheese and sour cream

Pour the pasta into the casserole pan top with meat mixture and sprinkle with the remaining cheese.
